• **P**rimary

Not secondary to another cause

• Sclerosing


- Stiffening with connective tissue (scarring)

• Cholangitis

– Inflammation of the bile ducts

- Top 3 Facts about PSC:
 - 1. Men are affected more than women
 - 2. Most PSC patients have colitis (IBD) All PSCers should have a colonoscopy
 - 3. Small duct PSC

Abnormal biopsy but normal ERC/MRC





- The course of PSC is unpredictable
 Varies from individual to individual
 Varies over time in the same individual
- <u>Average</u> time from diagnosis to liver transplant is 12 -15 years.





THE LIVER

- Bile duct obstruction
 - Ascending Cholangitis
 - RUQ pain, fever, jaundice
 - Jaundice (yellowing of skin and eyes)
- Cirrhosis





CANCER

• Most PSCers do NOT get cancer

• Risk of bile duct cancer (cholangiocarcinoma)

Risk of colon cancer with colitis

 Yearly colonoscopy

• Stress of the unknown








